





SETTING UP YOUR PC LAPTOP ON CAMPUS



- A.) Before you start, make sure that the PC power cord is plugged into either of the two USB-C ports on the right side of your laptop.
- B.) Open the lid.
- C.) Please follow these instructions step-by-step to personalize your laptop.



1. Power on your laptop using the button on the left side of the machine. You will see some black loading screens for a few minutes. This is normal.



4. Click the password box under the word Administrator. Type **winona** as the password then hit enter.





2. This screen will come up. Click on the screen once to move on to the next screen. If it looks like Windows is already logged in, please restart the computer and repeat this step.

Once you log in...

5. Give your computer 2-3 minutes to complete startup. You might see lots of pop ups and notifications. This is normal for the first boot of a new computer!


3. Once at the login screen, click the globe icon at the lower-right. Click on the "warrior" Wi-Fi network in the list and connect to it.




6. When you see the Winona State University setup assistant appear, click "Let's Get Started!"


7. Enter your **StarID** (it looks like this format: **ab1234cd**) For password, type the same password you use to connect to D2L, eservices, or your WSU email.




10. Log in with your **StarID** and password.




8. Click **contract**. A Chrome browser window will open.



11. Once you have read the agreement, scroll to the bottom of the webpage, and check the box acknowledging that you agree to the terms, and click "**submit**." You may now close Chrome.




9. Click on the "**Student eWarrior Technology Agreement**."




12. Click "**agree**."





13. Once you click agree, the computer will be renamed to resemble your **StarID**.





16. Once the policies have been set in place, the computer will reboot automatically.




14. The computer will also install some required WSU security software.

17. Once your computer restarts, verify that your device is connected to warrior Wi-Fi. You should see Wi-Fi bars, not a globe icon. If you see a globe icon, just click on it then find the warrior Wi-Fi network and click on it, then click connect.



15. Next, the computer will update "group policy," which just helps WSU set rules to manage the device.



18. Click "Other user" at the bottom-left of your screen.



19. Type your **StarID** followed by **@winona.edu** so that it looks something like this: **ab1234cd@winona.edu**

21. Once you see the Windows desktop, your setup should be complete.



20. Upon your first log in with your **StarID**, you will see screens that look like this.

22. To confirm your device has been set up correctly, just look for your name at the top left of the screen on your desktop.

Your device is now personalized and ready to use!
